The Criminal Division represents the state and the county in criminal matters in the King County District and Superior courts, the state and federal court of appeals, and the Washington and U.S. Supreme Courts.

Work Location: These are rotational positions between departments within the Criminal Division. Deputies can be assigned to any of the King County District Courts, Juvenile Court (1st Hill area), downtown Seattle court or Regional Justice Center in Kent. Most new hires start in one of the King County District Courts or at Juvenile Court.

Primary Job Functions/Qualifications: Candidates who are interested in gaining trial and other law practice skills, as well as making a difference in their community are encouraged to apply. Candidates must have excellent written and oral communication skills and have an interest in criminal trial practice. Prior experience in criminal law is a plus. Those interested in applying must be a citizen of the United States and Washington State Bar Qualified at the time of application.
