

**SECRET BALLOT
ANNUAL ELECTION
2004 GOVERNING COUNCIL
RE-VOTE
OCTOBER 1, 2003**

Section 5.020(d) of NIBA's By-Laws explains that only regular members, in good standing, can cast a ballot in the election of members to the Governing Council.

A regular member is "an Indian, Eskimo or Aleut person, and must also be a licensed attorney, judge, current law school student or graduate, or a full or part-time employee of a Native tribal court." See Section 1.010(a)(1). To be "in good standing," the regular member must have paid their annual membership dues before the Annual Meeting. See Section 1.040(d).

Sections 3.010 and 5.010 explain that the general membership elects, by majority vote, seven (7) members to the Governing Council. Subsequently, the newly-elected Governing Council members elect from among themselves, by majority vote, a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Please vote for a maximum of seven (7) members of the 2004 Governing Council.
